

RETRANSLATING MARC CHAGALL

Chantal Ringuet and Pierre Anctil

The two will discuss Mon univers. Autobiographie (Fides, 2017), their newly published (French) translation of Marc Chagall's Eygens—a series of paintings depicting key elements of the renowned painter's life, from his birth in Vitebsk in 1887, to his journeys through European capitals such as St. Petersburg, Paris and Moscow, finally returning to his native city in 1922. Engaged with current debates on the nature and role of retranslation, Mon univers.

Autobiographie presents the advantage of restoring the original manuscript in all of its uniqueness.

Chantal Ringuet is a Canadian award-winning author, scholar and translator. She is currently Research Associate at the HBI, Brandeis University. Pierre Anctil is a member of the Royal Society of Canada and a full professor at the Department of History, University of Ottawa.
